

Please check the weather prior to your scheduled date. We do pick in the rain so bring a rain jacket if the weather looks threatening. You may want to dress in layers and bring extra cloths in case you get wet. However, if weather conditions present a safety hazard we will postpone the harvest. We have your cell phone number and will try to contact you immediately if there is a delay. If for some reason we do postpone and we are unable to reschedule you, we will refund your deposit.

Please remember there are factors beyond our control such as weather, water availability, equipment operation or delays at the receiving station that have the ability to impact our harvest. We ask for your patience and understanding as we strive to make your experience as enjoyable as possible.

When you arrive at the farm park across the street from the cranberry barn and walk to the barn. We will have someone greet you in the barn to complete your registration and take your final payment. We took a 50% deposit when you made the reservation, the balance is paid when you arrive. You will then be transported to the bog by golf cart or you may walk. We will provide you with waders at the bog. The waders we provide require you to remove your shoes. I suggest wearing heavy socks. We have a variety of wader sizes (5-15), so we try to find a pair that will fit you. In some cases you may end up with a pair that is a size larger or smaller.

You should plan to arrive up to a half hour prior to your scheduled time. One of the best complements we ever received was from a young man who while putting on his waders said "This is the real deal". Yes it is, we are a real working farm and this is not Disney World.

We have a lot of fun with the *Be The Grower* experience, please feel free to bring a camera. We can take photos from the shore for you and you can bring the camera into the bog with you if you trust yourself to not get it wet.

The cranberry barn will have some cranberry products for sale including juice, fresh fruit, cranberry jam, T-shirts, sweat shirts, hats, cookbooks, children's book, cranberry bread and cranberry honey from our beekeeper. You are welcome to spend time walking the farm.

If you find you are unable to attend please let us know as soon as possible. The "Be The Grower" is sold out and we have over 120 people on a waiting list. If you have any questions please email. Once we start harvest it is a bit hectic for us and may not always return calls or emails immediately.

Additionally all participants are asked to sign a liability agreement. The agreement is attached and is also posted on our website. Copies will be available at registration.
